

## EXCURSION INFORMATION AND CONSENT FORM

Dear Parent/Caregiver

Gosford City Learning Community will be hosting a series of activities to celebrate NAIDOC Week on Friday 19 June 2015. As part of the celebrations, Gosford City Learning Community invites 30 students (indigenous and non-indigenous students) from each partner school to attend the event. To build cultural awareness, we suggest indigenous students invite a friend to attend to have a day to celebrate culture and community.

There is no cost for this excursion.

Dress to and from the venue: Full sports uniform, this includes suitable footwear. Students will also need to bring a hat, bottle of water and their morning tea. A BBQ lunch will be provided for all students.

There are a number of events planned for students to participate in on the day. The day will start at 9.30am and finish by 2.00pm. Below is an outline of the day's events.

9.10am	Bus arrives at Henry Kendall High School (Point Clare PS bus pick up at 9.00am)
9.30 – 11.00am	Outback Experience presented by Koomurri Aboriginal Incursions. The Outback Experience includes didgeridoo show, storytelling, Aboriginal song and dance, Aboriginal face painting, interactive Aboriginal art, boomerang throwing, artefacts and bush survival
11.00am – 11.40am	Recess – students to bring their own recess
11.40am – 12.40pm	Indigenous games on the oval led by Henry Kendall High School Indigenous leaders
12.40pm – 1.40pm	BBQ lunch provided by Henry Kendall High School
2.00pm	Bus leaves to return to respective schools

Travel will be by bus to and from school. Students will need to be at school at normal time.

The group will be supervised by teachers from Gosford Public School, Point Clare Public School, Henry Kendall High School and Gosford High School.
