EXCURSION INFORMATION AND CONSENT FORM

Dear Parent/Caregiver

Your child's class has the opportunity to participate in the Maths-in-Surveying program, a practical Maths excursion run by the University of New South Wales Surveying Department and a group of Maths teachers. This program is to be held at Bicentennial Park, Homebush Bay on Friday 23 October 2015.

This excursion is optional as it is an enrichment activity for Stage 5.3 Mathematics. The students will work in small groups, using their trigonometry skills to measure interesting features in the park, such as trees, obelisks, buildings and sun-dials. They will be assisted by qualified surveyors and Maths teachers. Real surveying equipment (such as theodolites) will be provided.

There are 15 places available on this excursion, and so the first 15 students to return their permission notes will attend. Students who do not attend the excursion will attend their regular classes.

The excursion will be supervised by Ms Jenny Lill. Travel will be by train. **The students are to meet Ms Lill at Gosford Station ticket office at 7:15 am**, in order to buy their own return ticket from Gosford to Concord West. The train will depart at 7:35am. We will return to Gosford Station between 4.00pm and 4:30pm approximately.

The cost of the excursion is approximately \$9. This is the price of the return concession train ticket. The program itself is free.

Full school uniform is required, including suitable footwear. Students not in full school uniform will not be permitted to attend. Suitable wet weather gear should also be carried. Students need to bring their own lunch and recess, including drinks, as there are no shops nearby. They also need a pen and scientific calculator.
