Faunce Street West, West Gosford –Proposed One-Way Eastern Traffic flow from Young Street to Batley Street

Dear Parents/Carers

Gosford City Council is seeking to address the safety and traffic concerns associated particularly with school drop off and pick up in Faunce Street West, West Gosford. Council is seeking in consultation with the schools, bus companies and NSW Police regarding development of a proposal to introduce one-way easterly traffic flow in the section of Faunce Street West between Young Street and Batley Street (see map over).

Council is also carrying out traffic modelling to ascertain the effect one-way traffic flow will have on the intersection of Batley Street and Racecourse Road. Whilst this modelling is being undertaken, comments are now sought from the community on the one-way traffic proposal. I encourage parents and carers of Henry Kendall High School to engage with this consultation process and provide comment to Council.


