30 – minute lessons are given once a week and run during class time on a weekly cycle. If the student is taking Elective Music as a subject then we try and timetable during one of their Music lessons that week, however this is not always possible. Please note that it is the students' responsibility to catch up on any work missed as part of their commitment to the program.

\$30	For an individual 30-minute lesson.
\$15 each	For a pair of students to have a lesson together. This is the best option for a group lesson due to space and student satisfaction.
\$10 each	For groups of three students. While we do offer this option, we only recommend it for special circumstances. Physical space in the room and limited equipment can hinder the students' satisfaction in this configuration.

Small group lessons are a great way to share the cost, however please be aware that you will need to find the other students who are willing to share your lesson.

Payments are not accepted at the front office. Please pay fees directly to the tutor with your contact details so they can be in touch if needed.
