## Senior Jackets 2017/2018

## Dear Parent/Guardian

Traditionally, senior students at Henry Kendall High School are eligible to purchase a senior jacket during their preliminary year. The senior jacket is part of the school uniform and is a valuable keepsake and reminder of their time at school. The specific style of the jackets will remain the same from year to year, although aspects of the jacket such as embroidered first name and a choice of nickname on the back can be chosen by the student.

Through discussions students, School Executive and members of the community, we have decided that the process for ordering and purchasing senior jackets will begin during Year 10. This means that your child will be able to wear a senior jacket during both Year 11 and 12. This makes the jacket more cost effective and allows students to wear them for a longer period of time.

The senior jacket will cost \$99.00 which can be paid in instalments:

1<sup>st</sup> instalment due 09/09/16 - \$20.00

2<sup>nd</sup> instalment due 23/09/16 - \$40.00 3<sup>rd</sup> instalment due 21/10/16 - \$39.00

To begin the process, the school requires a deposit of \$20.00 to the paid at the Front Office by Week 8, Term 3. Your child will receive a jacket during Term 1, 2017.
