Years 7 - 10 Sport Organisation – Term 3

Starting Week 2 (28 July 2020) and will continue until Week 10 Term 3 (22 September 2020)

Tuesday afternoon sport is an opportunity for students to further develop their movement related skills in a physically active environment. Henry Kendall High School offers a variety of sporting and recreational activities to enable students to meet the mandatory requirements for sport as set out by the NSW Department of Education and Training.

Sport Selection Process

- Step 1 - Follow the link and use your DET login and password <https://online.schoolbytes.education/sport/>.
- Step 2 - Select 3 sport options for Term 3 2020. *Payment will open once the selection period has closed. **Note: Payments cannot be processed before students have received their confirmation email. These include online payments.***
- Step 3 - Students will receive an email from Monday 29 June with confirmation of their sport.
- Step 4 - Sports requiring payment can then be paid online via School Bytes or at the front office. All payments and a permission note MUST be completed by Thursday 23 July.
- Step 5 - Permission notes need to be handed in to the front office by Thursday 23 July. **Permission notes signed by a parent MUST be returned to the front office before students can commence their chosen sport.**

Requirements and General Information

- * Students will be placed in their first choice unless it is full.
- * Payments can be made online via School Bytes, over the phone or at the front office from Monday 29 June. Permission note MUST be completed with payment.
- * Any student who does not make a selection will be placed in a sport at the discretion of the sports organiser.
- * If not enough students select a particular sport, that sport will not run.
- * All students are encouraged to wear hats and sunscreen during outdoor activities and bring their own water bottle.
- * No refunds will be given for withdrawal from sport for poor behaviour, if the student is absent, or if the student does not attend their allocated sport.
- * All students will wear the correct Henry Kendall High School sports uniform. Students may wear this to school all day if they choose. If for any reason this is not possible a note must be supplied and an appropriate change of clothes brought instead.
- * Students who report to school ill or injured on Tuesdays and bring a note of explanation will complete supervised work in a classroom.
- * Students who miss the bus will complete supervised written work in a classroom.
- * Sport is a **mandatory requirement** for each student and attendance is compulsory.
