On Thursday 15 October Years 9, 10 and 11 will be attending a 1 hour wellbeing presentation from Red Frogs.

Red Frogs is an organisation that work to safeguard young people at Schoolies Week, universities, high schools, music festivals and sporting events. The presentations on Thursday will engage students' critical thinking skills and strengthen their personal and social capabilities. The focus is to prepare students for the various situations they will face in Australian society and culture. The presentations and period allocation are as follows:

Period 1- IDENTITY PROGRAM - Year 9

Every young person has inherent worth, value and great potential for their future. This program has a two-fold focus - it explores both self-worth and the worth of others. This program has been designed to assist young people to discover their identity and be confident in the way in which they are wired. Students will leave encouraged and excited about who they are and the future that lies ahead.

Period 2- SCHOOLIES/LEAVERS PROGRAM - Year 11

Our signature program focuses on the issues we have seen young people encounter during their end-of-school celebrations. Presenters will share real-life stories gained from their personal experiences and our involvement in Schoolies since 1997. Students will be empowered to make positive life choices not only at Schoolies Week but in any party environment in which they may find themselves.

Period 3- PARTY SAFE PROGRAM - Year 10

Our Party Safe program will empower students to be equipped to make informed decisions in the situations they may be confronted with in party environments. Presenters will inspire students to generate their own convictions, become aware of the consequences of risky behaviour and make positive life choices.

These presentations are compulsory and there is no cost to the students.
